To receive the Certificate, you also need:

- A current First Aid certificate (achieved less than 3 years ago)
- A current safety check (less than 3 years ago).
- To have been observed within the previous 12 months to assess your competency and complete a consistency questionnaire providing meaningful reflection on your achievement of the graduate outcomes.

TRANSITION INFORMATION



If you already have a qualification, here is some information on how you can transfer into the New Education Programme.

For licensing purposes, during transition the PIA is interchangeable with **COURSE 1**

COURSE 2 towards **PIA**

If you have completed Course 2 and would like to achieve a PIA you can start at B402 workshop 3 & 4.

For licensing purposes, during transition the PEA is interchangeable with **COURSE 2**

COURSE 2 towards **PEA**

If you have completed Course 2 and would like to achieve the PEA you need to do B402 workshops 3 & 4, all of B403 and B404 workshops 1, 3 & 4.

COURSE 3 towards **PEA**

If you have completed Course 3 and would like to achieve the PEA you need to do B404 workshops 1, 3 & 4.

COURSE 3 towards **LEVEL 4**

If you have completed Course 3 and would like to achieve Level 4 you need to do B404 workshops 1, 3 & 4, C405, C407, C408 2 of 5 workshops, C409 and C410 1 of 3 workshops.

COURSE 4 and above are higher level qualifications and will remain recognised in the new licensing beyond the transition period. Therefore, if you have already completed Course 4 you are unable to, and do not need to, transfer to the new programme.
