Location

Hours

Space facilitator contracts are fixed term for the length of each programme. The programme usually runs for three terms and is 3.5 hours a week. Some of our Space facilitators run more than one programme and so being a Space facilitator can be a very viable part time role that fits within school hours.

- Have Playcentre Course 4 or hold an ECE degree or diploma. Playcentre Course 3 applicants will be considered with preference given to those working toward Playcentre Course 4 or the NZ Certificate of Early Childhood Education and Care (L4) .
- Hold a current First Aid Certificate or prepared to complete this training (paid for by NZPF)
- Be a fantastic communicator with the ability to speak within a group.
- Be prepared to complete Space NZ training online and face to face (paid for by NZPF)
- Be prepared to facilitate at multiple locations
