Playcentre Aotearoa distributed information regarding the Decision Paper: Titiro whakamuri — Regional Rōpū Māori name via the Playcentre Aotearoa national communications, all Te Whare Tikanga Māori members were given the opportunity to respond. Governance did not receive any responses to the proposed new Regional Rōpū Māori names.

Introduction

At Hui ā-Tau Māori May 2019, The meeting agreed to accept the Tātai Tautanga|Succession Plan that was tabled.

Post Hui, Legal advice was sought to ensure the best possible option is put forward to Te Whare Tikanga Māori and the wider organisation. Te Whānau Tupu Ngātahi o Aotearoa — Playcentre Aotearoa constitution indicates that:

- Te Whare Tikanga Māori shall be responsible for: 7.6.5. selection of a minimum of three (3) members up to a maximum of five (5) members of the Trustee Board and such other Officers as may be deemed necessary;
- 10.10.7. endorse the Co-Presidents selected by each House; and
- 10.10.8. endorse up to four (4) Trustees selected by Te Whare Tikanga Māori;
