



Pinehaven Playcentre in Te Awakakairangi ki Uta began their collaboration with Enviroschools Te Upoko o Te Ika a Māui in 2017. Early last term, they shared their inspirational experience with other Playcentre whānau of how their tamariki are engaged with their environment. Growing and cooking kai is a regular activity for tamariki and their whānau. In 2022 they established systems to identify and deal with organic waste, grow kai, collect seeds and feed the community. They have also installed wormfarms and bokashi systems. Together they have created sustainable practises at centre, in the community and at home.
